
## **RESIDENT ROOM/BATHROOM**

## **Resident Room**

- 1 Con Door handle
- 2 Light switches
- 3 Furniture and handles (tables, chairs, dresser, nightstand, etc.)
- 4 TV remote
- 5 🚷 Telephone
- 6 + Nurse call light
- 7 Faucet and sink
- 8 🏠 Trash/recycling receptacles
- Any room items resident has added alarm clock, hair dryer, cane, wheelchair arms, etc.
- 10 Thermostat

## **Resident Bathroom**

- Door handles
- 2 Light switches
- ② Dispensers (soap, toilet paper, etc.)
- 4 Paper towel holders
- **5 J** Toilet (handle, seat, etc.)
- 6 Handrails
- Faucet/shower handle/sink/tub
- 8 Trash/recycling receptacle
- 9 🔯 Floors/walls
